Regional Commentary

Owner-occupiers and first home buyers were the most active buyer groups, with reports of fewer lifestyle and investment buyers.

Most vendors are listening and adjusting their prices to meet market expectations, with some choosing to remove their properties in anticipation of a lift later this year. Open home attendance varied, with good numbers reported at new listings in Whangarei, whereas private viewings are popular elsewhere.

Low attendance was recorded at some auctions. However negotiations in the auction room produced some good results. As vendors began to accept the current market, confidence among vendors and buyers slowly increased. Local agents report that interest rates and lending criteria didn't hold buyers back in July and are hopeful for a further lift in confidence towards the end of the year.
